

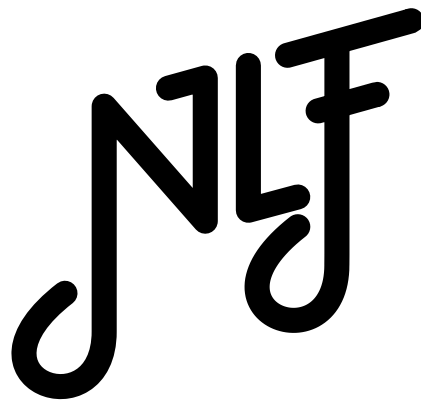

**Instrumental Chamber Music – String and Mixed Groups**  
**Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2:00 pm**

These competitions are intended to be mainly for string and/or harp players. Every group entering must have at least one string player or harpist.



A £50 voucher from **Stringers of London** will be awarded to each player in the most outstanding string ensemble of up to 8 players.

A £50 cash prize, donated by CAMAC Harps, will be awarded to the harp player who makes the most outstanding contribution to their group's performance.

A £50 cash prize, donated by Hilary Sturt, will be awarded to the viola player who makes the most outstanding contribution to their group's performance.

A £50 cash prize, in memory of David Angel, will be awarded to the second violinist who makes the most outstanding contribution to their group's performance.

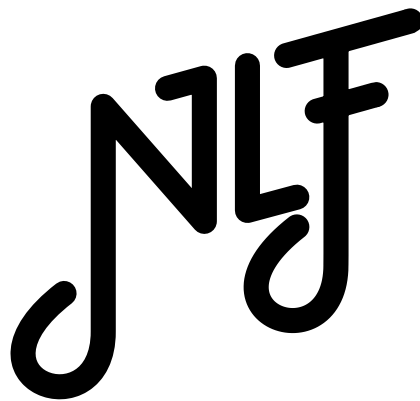
