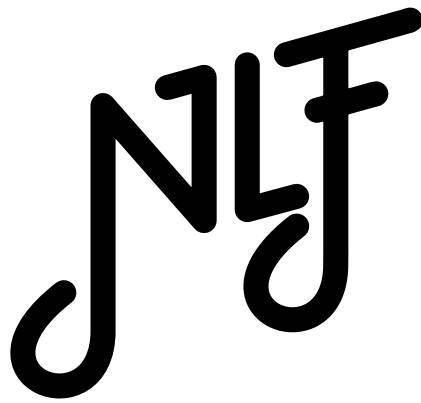

Candidates for any of the harp competitions should be studying or resident in the United Kingdom or Ireland and must provide the adjudicator with a clean copy of the music for each work to be performed. For competitions G02–G05 all pieces performed are to be from current ABRSM or TCL grade lists.

Please note that, due to the change of date of the early-May Bank Holiday, harp competitions will take place after the rest of the Festival has finished.

G02	<b>Recital – any age, Grade 1-2.</b> Two contrasting pieces. A £25 cash prize will be awarded.	5	15.00
G03	<b>Recital – any age, Grade 3-4.</b> Two contrasting pieces. A £30 cash prize will be awarded.	6	15.00
G04	<b>Recital – any age, Grade 5-6.</b> Two contrasting pieces. A £40 cash prize will be awarded.	10	16.00
G05	<b>Recital – any age, Grade 7-8.</b> Two contrasting pieces. A £50 cash prize will be awarded.	12	17.00
G06	<b>Study – 13 and under.</b> Any harp study.	5	15.00
G07	<b>Study – 18 and under.</b> Any harp study.	10	16.00

Harpists are eligible to enter string competitions and may be interested in performing their own compositions.

Harp chamber ensemble competitions will this year be combined with string chamber music competitions – see the *Instrumental Chamber Music – String and Mixed Groups* section of the syllabus.

Non-classical harpists should look at the *folk music class, E26* in the *Large Instrumental Ensembles, Orchestras and Folk Music* section.

### **First Round – Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2020**

Two contrasting pieces to be performed. Time limit 15 mins

### **Final – Monday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2020**

Short recital programme of 1-3 pieces to be performed.

Time limit 20 mins

### **Adjudicators: Caryl Thomas and Sally Pryce**

Harpists should be of conservatoire standard or beyond, studying or resident in the United Kingdom or Ireland. Age limit: 30

Candidates must provide the adjudicator with a clean copy of the music for each work to be performed.

**Entry Fee: £35**

**First Prize – £500** and a paid lunchtime recital opportunity on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020 as part of the *Proms at St Jude's*, in Hampstead Garden Suburb Free Church, Central Square, NW11 7AG. Candidates should be available for the concert date.

**Second Prize – £200**

**Third Prize – £100**

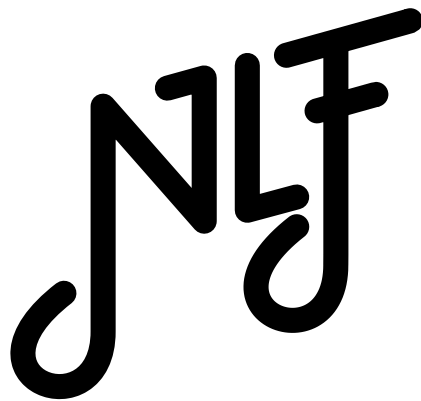
